

SFMHS History Cruise May 3rd

Two favorite islands in San Francisco Bay are steeped in history. Angel Island was home to Indian settlements, military installations and served as a Quarantine and Immigration station in the early 1900s, as well as a POW camp and even a Nike missile base.

Alcatraz boasts the first lighthouse on the Pacific Coast, installed in 1853, which was torn down in 1909 to make way for a military prison; and in 1934, the island served as a federal penitentiary.

We will sail around both these islands and learn their fascinating stories on our Red and White Fleet History Cruise of San Francisco Bay on Saturday, May 3. Historians from the National Maritime Museum will join us to talk about the historical significance of Alcatraz and Angel Islands, as well as other landmarks.

The 90-minute voyage sails at 5 PM from Gate E on The Embarcadero, just south of the Ferry Building. Tickets are \$45.

Free food will be provided, courtesy of Boudin Bakery, and the bar will be open for the purchase of soft drinks, beer and wine.

Tickets will not be mailed, but will be held at Gate E beginning at 4:30 PM. Parking is available at the Pier ½ Parking Lot, just north of the Ferry Building on The Embarcadero; Washington & Embarcadero Parking Lot; and the Howard Street Parking Garage, 75 Howard St. at Steuart.
